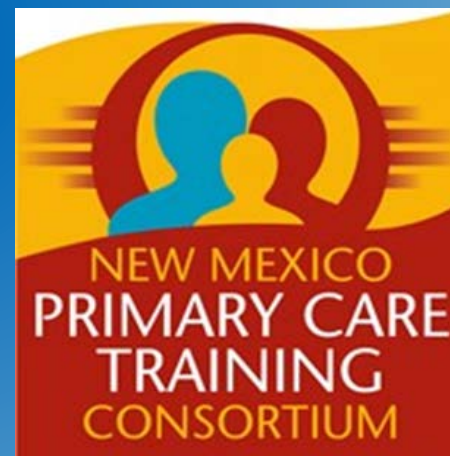

New Mexico is an innovative leader in training family medicine physicians and other primary care providers working in the most underserved populations in high quality integrated primary care health systems.

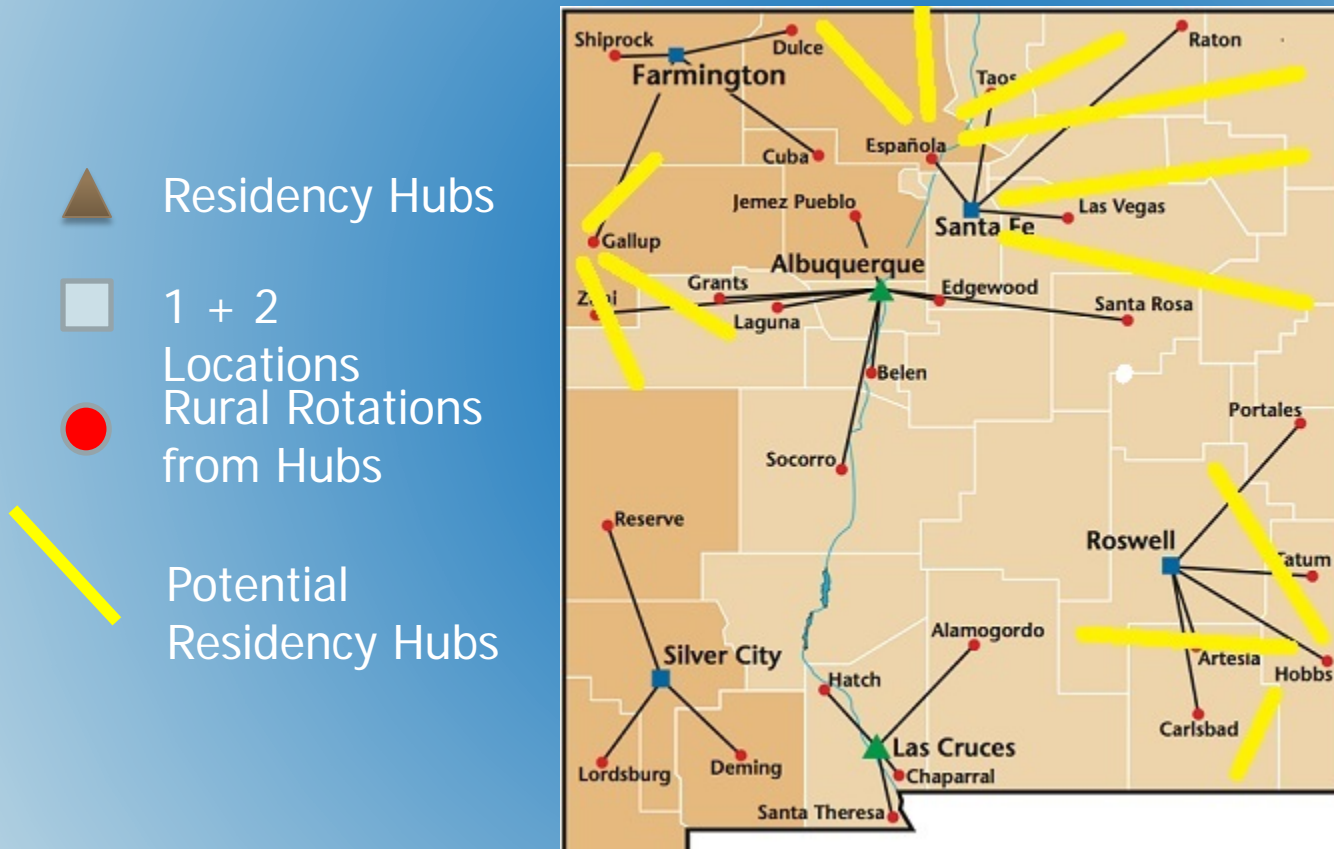
