Directly below is a list of the State Opiate Treatment Programs that provide methadone and/or suboxone for Molina members. In addition to these providers, Molina also has a number of physicians who are certified to provide suboxone. During this report timeframe, we had 255 individual physicians who have prescribed suboxone for adults, some with just 1 or 2 patients. There is no prior auth requirement for MAT services. Average wait time to receive services is approximately 4 – 6 weeks.
