

# U.S. Prescription Drug Cost/Health Care Expenditures



#### **Patient Burden of Costs**

- 18% of patients pay out of pocket
- Medicare/Medicaid patients were more likely to manage costs by not taking medications
- Adults living between 139-400% FPL were more likely to ask for lower cost prescriptions

Albuterol inhaler	\$55-60
Qvar steroid inhaler	\$205-227

Lisinopril	4.00	7.04	5.00	6.14	9.19

Atorvastatin	12.11	10.63	14.15	12.11	60.64
TOTAL	\$44.71	\$59.78	\$134.30	\$74.84	\$165.8

## **Take Away Points**

- Prescription drug prices are rising rapidly
- Transparency in cost of production, research and development, and marketing
- Flexibility to negotiate volume discounts and bulk purchasing
- Policies to increase competition for brandname and generic sole-source drugs
