## **HB75:** historic compromise

For decades, legislators urged disagreeing parties to compromise on solutions to addressing patient harm. The historic HB75 compromise was written and supported by:

- NM Medical Society
- NM Hospital Association
- NM Nurses' Association
- NM Trial Attorneys
- All stood in support in Senate Judiciary
- \*Only 5 Senators voted against
