Program Statistics


- Our program here in New Mexico opened in 2001, but Youth ChalleNGe began nationally in 1993.
- Currently there are 40 programs throughout the country, including Puerto Rico, Hawaii, Alaska & the District of Columbia.
- The Program received 75% federal and 25% state funding.
- Graduation target of 200 cadets per year.
- Over 3,030 graduates to date in New Mexico!
- No cost to applicants or families for enrollment, housing, education, clothing or meals.
- NMNGYCA serves the ENTIRE state of New Mexico.
- New Mexico is excited to offer credit recovery beginning in 2023, where New Mexico youth will be able to earn HS credits while attending and have the option to return to high school.

Program Graduates by County

The New Mexico National Guard Youth ChalleNGe Academy has completed 42 cycles, with Cycle 43 scheduled to graduate on December 17, 2022.

Since 2001, 3,034 New Mexico youth have graduated from the Program!

Program Eligibility

Basic qualifications for acceptance:

- 1. Between 16-18 years of age
- 2. Dropped out of high school, or at risk of dropping out
- 3. Willing to be drug free
- 4. Mentally and physically capable of participation
- 5. Cannot be under indictment, or ever convicted of a felony and not currently on parole or probation for other than juvenile status offenses
- A citizen or lawful permanent resident of US and have a valid New Mexico ID
- 7. Voluntarily applying for enrollment
