NM Veteran Suicide Statistics

According to the New Mexico VA Health Care System

New Mexico is ranked 4th highest in the nation for veteran suicide rate

1 veteran commits suicide every 4 days, or 75-90 veterans commit suicide per year

State Government Funding for Veteran Mental Health Care

According to the NM Legislature Website

There were 77 bills introduced that had anything to do with mental health.

Of those 77 bills, only two had any mention of veterans:

HB 2 - \$25,000 for Veterans Treatment Courts in the 3rd Judicial District

SB 277 - \$97,600 to DVS for Disabled Veterans

\$97,600 to DVS for homeless Veterans

New Mexico Veteran Population

According to the New Mexico Department of Veteran Services, as of January 2021

Total Veteran Population: 151,279

Vietnam Veterans: 53,251

Gulf War (including Post 9/11) Veterans: 63,703

According to the New Mexico Department of Veteran Services, as of January 2020

Total Veteran Population: 154,172

Vietnam Veterans: 53,017

Gulf War (including Post 9/11) Veterans: 62,094
