

#### The Future of Field Services

- Retain VSOs: create career opportunities, increase education, retainment bonuses
   -Administrative Clerks in all offices (maintain office opening)
- Utilize 4 Quadrant, statewide mobile VSO teams (4 Vans, 8 VSOs total)
- VSO call center (Answer calls, make appointments, provide general assistance)
- Leverage existing state/tribal partnerships (Offer VSO training to all Pueblos, Nations and Tribes)
- Improve data collection- new data base, quality control of claims and appeals
- Implement new programs- discharge upgrades, incarcerated veterans
- New Mexico State Veterans ID card- Incorporate veteran information into QR code
