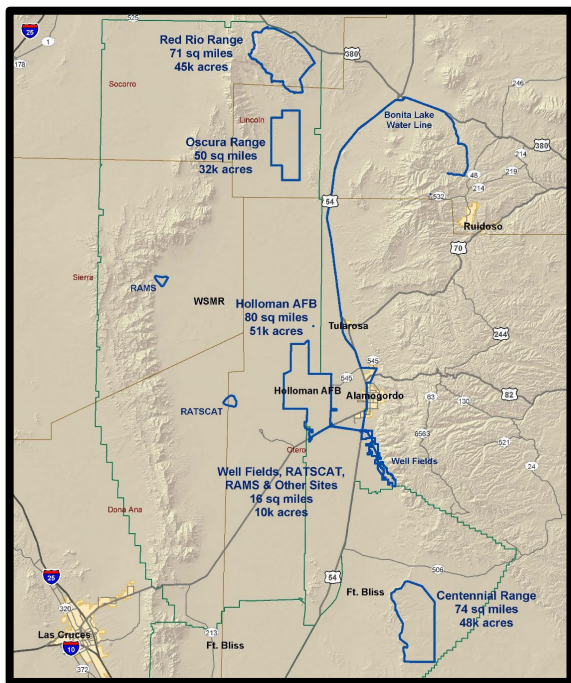

- ~1,100 On-base Homes

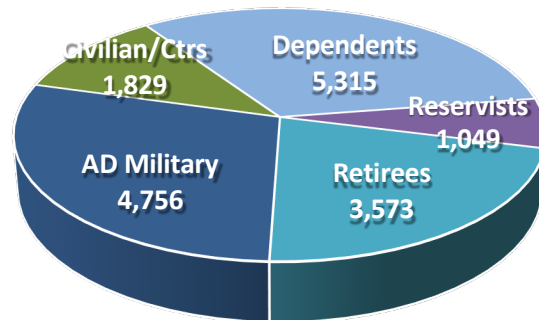

# Holloman Housing Overview

## ON BASE

- Soaring Heights/Lendlease
  - ACC Group 2 HAFB/DM
- 1,061 On-Base Homes
- Available to military families, retirees, & unaccompanied members
- New Builds, Fully renovated, Minimally renovated

## UNACCOMPANIED

- 15 On-Base Dorms
  - 855 Rooms
- E1-E3 and E4 with less than 3 years of service
- **Holloman AFB is short 66 dorm rooms**

## COMMUNITY

- ~3,100 members
- Across all local communities
- **The community is short housing options for 1,168 people**

***BOTTOM LINE: an increased number of affordable housing options are needed in Alamogordo... not only for our military members, but the community at large.***

# Holloman Schools



## 24 public and private schools in Otero County

- 32% of private school enrollment is military

## Holloman Elementary (built: 1952; 1962-63; 1974)

- 500 students and 43 teaching staff

## Holloman Middle School (built: 1973)

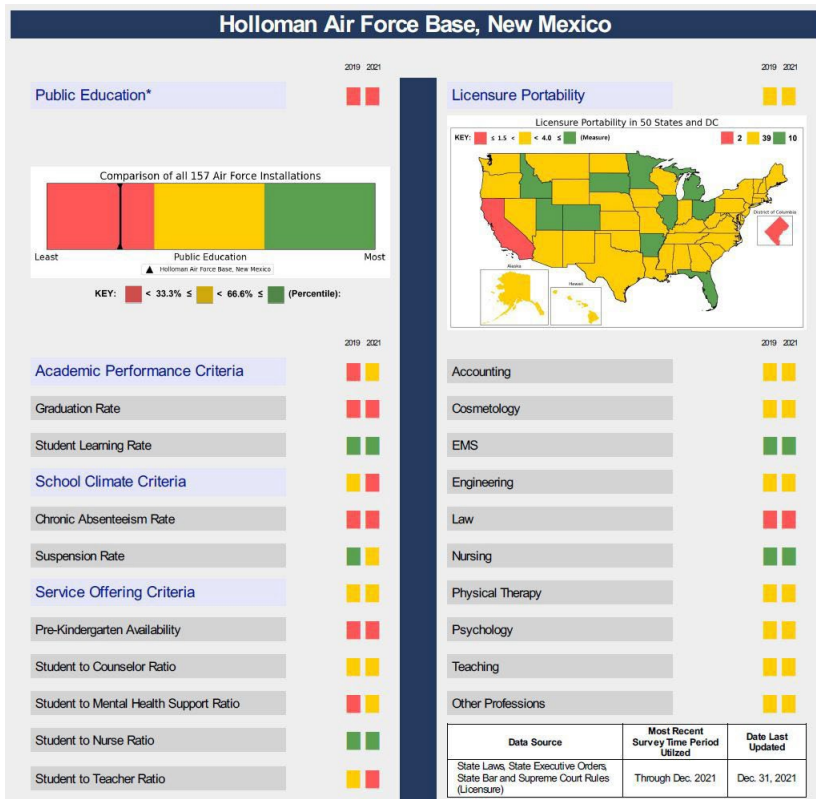
- 200 students and 18 teaching staff
- 1 full time embedded MFLC

## Alamogordo HS (built 1968; 1991)

- 275 AD, Guard/Reserve dependents

## Licensure Portability

- No change to assessment
- NM HB 30 signed “*Expedited Licensure for Military Families and Veterans*,” FEB 2020
  - 30-day timeline for education
  - 60-day timeline for other professions

# CDC and Childcare



- 58 of 165 on-base providers despite benefits, competitive pay
  - 44/147 CDC
  - 14/18 School Age/Youth
- 2 CDC bldgs, YC/SAC
  - 1 CDC closed since 6/21
- Extensive wait list
- In-Home Care Licensure
  - Timeline largest impediment





# Holloman Support to OAW



- Tasked to ALLIES WELCOME on 25 AUG
- More than 900 US personnel deployed to HAFB
  - Tent city for 1.2K fully operational in 7 days
- Temporary housing 5K Afghan guests
  - Mostly children and families
  - Providing general services until visa apps processed
- Mission Ended in Jan 30, 2022. All contractor built temp facilities have been removed



# Why Holloman Was Chosen



- 1 of 7 installations participating
- A lot of unimproved, DoD-owned land
  - 3rd largest USAF base
- Ready to execute now
  - Only organic Basic Expeditionary Airfield Resources (BEAR) unit
