AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCE; AUTHORIZING THE NEW MEXICO FINANCE  
AUTHORITY TO MAKE LOANS FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS FROM THE PUBLIC  
PROJECT REVOLVING FUND; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1. [NEW MATERIAL] AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECTS.--**

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, the  
legislature authorizes the New Mexico finance authority to make  
loans from the public project revolving fund for public  
projects as defined in Section 6-21-3 NMSA 1978. Pursuant to  
Section 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, loans of less than one million  
dollars (\$1,000,000) do not require specific authorization and  
need not be identified in this act. Authorization is given to  
the New Mexico finance authority to make loans to the following

23 124. the West Las Vegas public school district in  
24 San Miguel county for building, equipment, infrastructure, debt  
25 refinance, road, land acquisition, water, wastewater, water

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1 rights and solid waste projects;

2 125. the village of Willard in Torrance county for  
3 building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road, land  
4 acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid waste  
5 projects; and

6 126. the village of Williamsburg in Sierra county  
7 for building, equipment, infrastructure, debt refinance, road,  
8 land acquisition, water, wastewater, water rights and solid  
9 waste projects.

10 SECTION 2. [NEW MATERIAL] VOIDING OF AUTHORIZATION.--If a  
11 qualified entity listed in Section 1 of this act has not  
12 certified to the New Mexico finance authority by the end of  
13 fiscal year 2017 its desire to continue to pursue a loan from  
14 the public project revolving fund for a public project listed  
15 in that section, the legislative authorization granted to the  
16 New Mexico finance authority by Section 1 of this act to make a  
17 loan from the public project revolving fund to that qualified  
18 entity for that public project is void.

19 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
20 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
