AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECTS. -- Pursuant to 17 Section 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, the legislature authorizes the New 18 Mexico finance authority to make loans from the public project 19 revolving fund for public projects as defined in Section 6-21-3 20 NMSA 1978. Pursuant to Section 6-21-6 NMSA 1978, loans of one 21 million dollars (\$1,000,000) or less do not require specific authorization and need not be identified in this act. 22 Authorization is given to the New Mexico finance authority to 23 24 make loans to the following qualified entities on terms and 25 conditions established by the authority: .223386.1SA
