Background

- New Mexico has 61 million square feet of public school facilities, with a current replacement cost of approximately \$19.5 billion.
- The three major factors facing public school facilities today are:
 - Available Funding;
 - Total Replacement Value (Gross Square Footage); and
 - Maintenance Effectiveness (Ability to maintain facilities conditions to achieve the full expected life of the facilities).




Cost of Ownership Analysis

Using benchmarks set forth by the National Research Council in 1990, the PSFA evaluated New Mexico school district spending trends, as it related to Maintenance and Operations (M&O) and Capital Outlay.

General Category	Specific Facility Expenditure Category	Best Practice Annual Minimum Estimated Investment
Funded with the general operating budget		
M&O	Facility Operations	1% of CRV
M&O	Routine Maintenance	1.5-2% of CRV
Funded with the capital budget		
Modernization	Capital Outlay	1.5 – 2% of CRV
Modernization	Major Modernization	Depends on building condition
New Construction	Obsolete Building Replacement	Depends on building condition
New Construction	New Construction for Growth	Depends on enrollment growth







Educational GSF v. PSCOC Adequacy Standards GSF


If all schools were built to the PSCOC's Adequacy Standards, the number of districts having the capacity to meet spending benchmarks would increase dramatically.

Average Annual School Districts Expenditures on Capital Renewal and M&O by Assessed Value Quintiles, 2013 - 2014


