Water Quality Permits at LANL

• LANL Wastewater Permit (NM 0028355)

- Regulates discharges from 11 outfalls.
- Types of discharges: power plant, high explosives plant, sanitary wastewater plant, radioactive liquid waste treatment facility.
- Draft permit due out soon. Public meeting anticipated in November or December 2019.

• LANL Individual Stormwater Permit (IP) (NM 0030759)

- Regulates stormwater discharges from 400 historic industrial stormwater sites.
- Regulates pollutants such as PCBs, heavy metals, gross alpha, and other pollutants.
- Draft permit due out soon. Public meeting in November or December 2019.

• LANL MSGP (General Industrial Stormwater permit)

- Regulates general ongoing industrial activities
- Potential MS4 Stormwater Permit for Urban Stormwater Discharges
 - Amigos Bravos petitioned EPA to require Clean Water Act coverage of urban stormwater discharges in Los Alamos County (LANL, LA County and NMDOT) (2014).
 - EPA made preliminary determination that coverage should be required (2015).
 - Amigos Bravos filed lawsuit against EPA for their failure to make a final determination (2019).

• State Groundwater Discharge Permit (DP) 1132

- DP for the Radioactive Liquid Waste Treatment Facility (RLWTF) regulates radioactive liquid waste up to 40,000 gallons per day.
- A new hearing on the permit is scheduled for November 14th, 2019 in Los Alamos.

• State Groundwater Discharge Permit (DP) 1793

- Allows for the land application of 350,000 gpd of treated (previously contaminated) groundwater
- It is an umbrella permit for individual work plans to treat chromium, high explosives, pump test waters, etc.
- A new hearing on this permit is expected in March 2020.
- Discharge Permit (DP) 1835
 - allows the reinjection of 680,000 gpd of treated groundwater to the regional drinking water aquifer.
 - This permit is associated with Chromium plume mitigation work.
