Food and Medical Deductions

- **Deduction; gross receipts; sale of food at retail food store** -- Receipts from the sale of food at a retail food store that are not exempt from gross receipts taxation and are not deductible pursuant to another provision of the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act may be deducted from gross receipts. [Section 7-9-92(A) NMSA 1978] (enacted in 2004)
- **Deduction; gross receipts; certain receipts for services provided by health care practitioner** -- Receipts from payments by a managed health care provider or health care insurer for commercial contract services or medicare part C services provided by a health care practitioner that are not otherwise deductible pursuant to another provision of the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act may be deducted from gross receipts, provided that the services are within the scope of practice of the person providing the service. Receipts from fee-for-service payments by a health care insurer may not be deducted from gross receipts. [Section 7-9-93 NMSA 1978] (enacted in 2007)

Hold Harmless Provisions

Sections 7-1-6.46 and 7-1-6.47 NMSA 1978

Distribution to municipalities; offset for food deduction and health care practitioner services deduction.

- A. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 NMSA 1978 shall be made to a municipality in an amount, subject to any increase or decrease made pursuant to Section 7-1-6.15 NMSA 1978, [. . . continuing on to describe distributions to be provided to municipalities of differing qualifying characteristics];
- B. The distribution pursuant to Subsection A of this section is in lieu of revenue that would have been received by the municipality but for the deductions provided by Sections 7-9-92 and 7-9-93 NMSA 1978. The distribution shall be considered gross receipts tax revenue and shall be used by the municipality in the same manner as gross receipts tax revenue, including payment of gross receipts tax revenue bonds.
- C. For the purposes of this section, "business locations attributable to the municipality" means business locations:
 - (1) within the municipality;
 - (2) on land owned by the state, commonly known as the "state fairgrounds", within the exterior boundaries of the municipality;
 - (3) outside the boundaries of the municipality on land owned by the municipality; and
 - (4) on an Indian reservation or pueblo grant in an area that is contiguous to the municipality and in which the municipality performs services pursuant to a contract between the municipality and the Indian tribe or Indian pueblo if:
 - (a) the contract describes an area in which the municipality is required to perform services and requires the municipality to perform services that are substantially the same as the services the municipality performs for itself; and
 - (b) the governing body of the municipality has submitted a copy of the contract to the secretary.
- D. A distribution pursuant to this section may be adjusted for a distribution made to a tax increment development district with respect to a portion of a gross receipts tax increment dedicated by a municipality pursuant to the Tax Increment for Development Act [5-15-1 NMSA 1978]. [Sections 7-1-6.46 and 7-1-6.47 NMSA 1978]

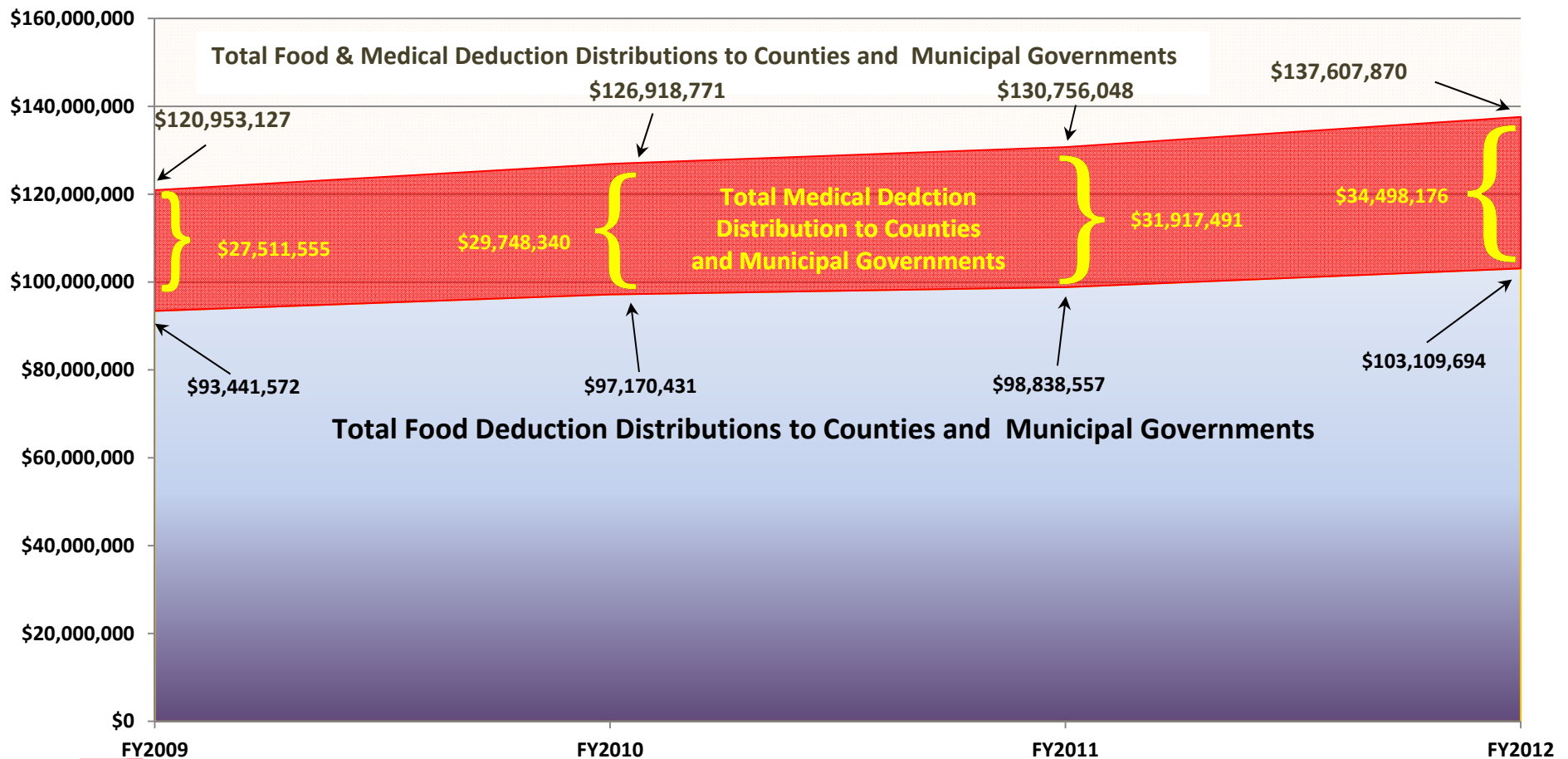
Distribution to counties; offset for food deduction and health care practitioner services deduction.

- A. A distribution pursuant to Section 7-1-6.1 NMSA 1978 shall be made to a county in an amount, subject to any increase or decrease made pursuant to Section 7-1-6.15 NMSA 1978, equal to the sum of: [. . . continuing on to describe distributions to be provided to counties of differing qualifying characteristics];
- B. The distribution pursuant to Subsection A of this section is in lieu of revenue that would have been received by the county but for the deductions provided by Sections 7-9-92 and 7-9-93 NMSA 1978. The distribution shall be considered gross receipts tax revenue and shall be used by the county in the same manner as gross receipts tax revenue, including payment of gross receipts tax revenue bonds.
- C. A distribution pursuant to this section may be adjusted for a distribution made to a tax increment development district with respect to a portion of a gross receipts tax increment dedicated by a county pursuant to the Tax Increment for Development Act [5-15-1 NMSA 1978]. [Sections 7-1-6.46 and 7-1-6.47 NMSA 1978]
