## Funding Local Capital Projects – continued

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### Lack of Coordination

- Between State Programs: Every program has a different
  - Application
  - Funding cycle
  - Scoring criteria
  - Board
  - Loan/grant agreement
  - Set of terms and conditions
- Between Local Governments
- Between the State and the Federal Government

### Perspective Matters

- Local governments focus on getting as much for their community as they can for as little money out of their constituents pockets (i.e., they go for grants first, then loans, then their own)
- State needs to focus on stretching state dollars (i.e., make sure the local and feds contributions are maximized and get largest number of projects done with the money that is available)
