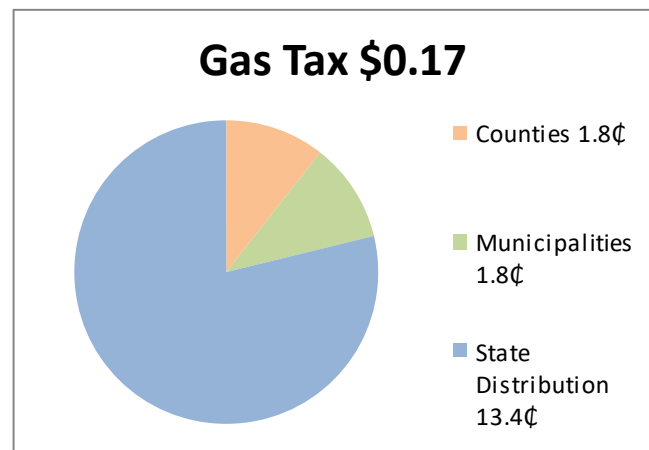
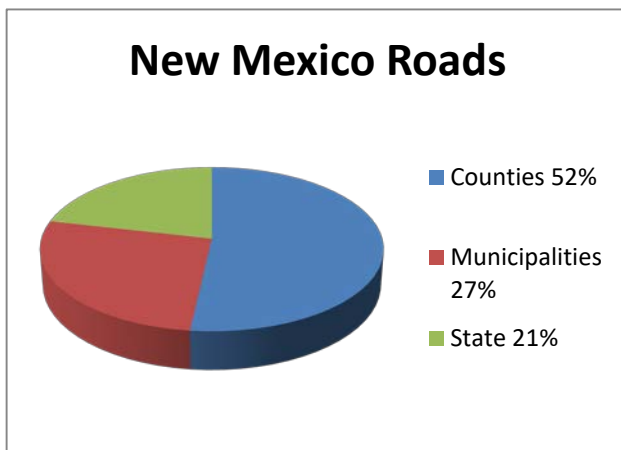


New Mexico County Road Concerns

Road Mileage

- ~29,000 Miles of county roads
- ~15,000 Miles of municipal roads
- ~12,000 Miles of state roads (based on centerline line of hwy)



Main Road Issues

- Counties cannot fund new or large scale projects (ex. bridges, bypass roads)
 - Counties responsible for majority of NM roads
 - County road budgets decreasing
 - Counties are in “preventative road maintenance mode”
 - Decrease in oil & gas revenues
 - Heavy truck loads = majority of road damage (1 truck = 3000 cars)
- County reliance on state/federal funding for major projects
 - Decrease in capital outlay funds
 - Decrease in federal grants
 - Funding request process difficult to manage and time consuming
 - Counties receive ~1.8¢ from Gas Tax (only 10.38% of the 17¢/gallon tax)
