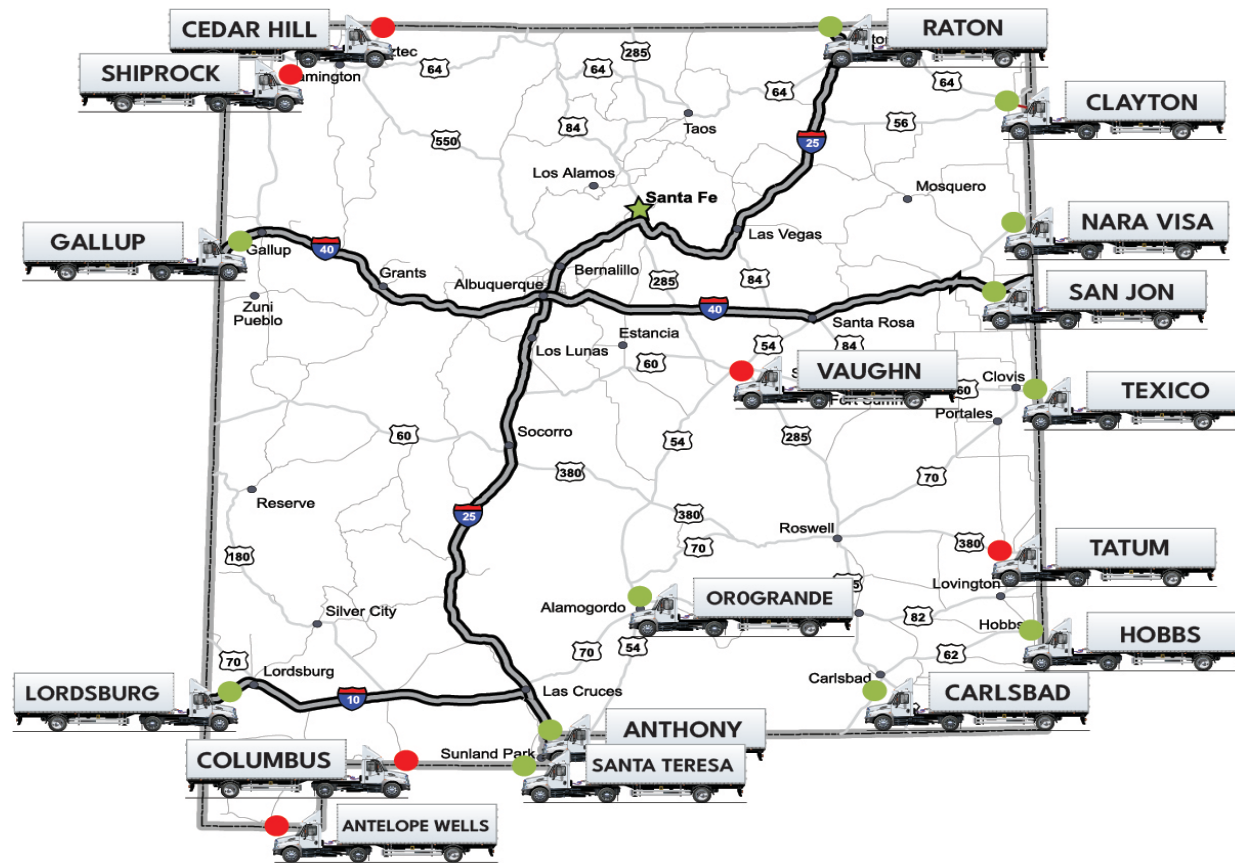

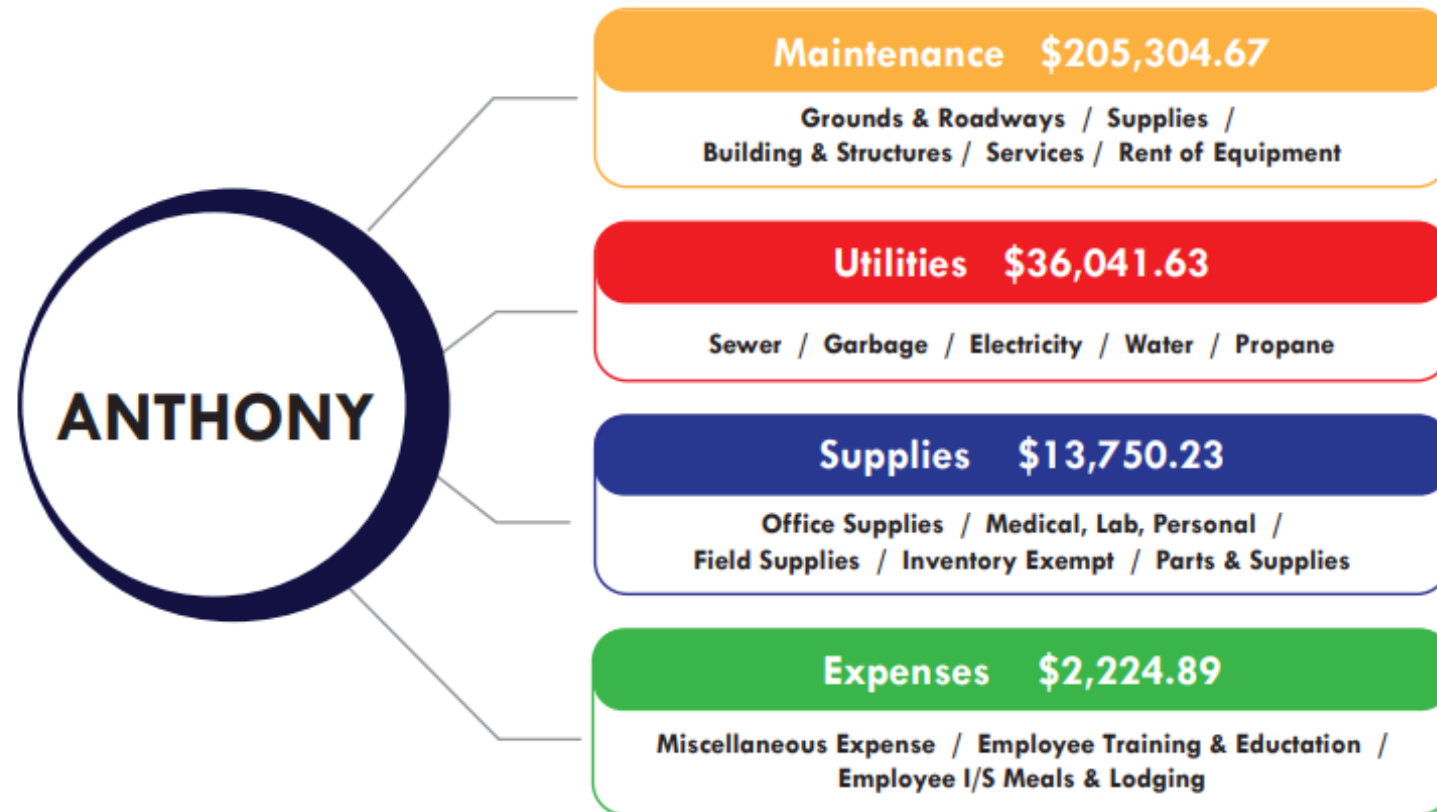
Oversight and Maintenance

2021 Senate Joint Resolution Transferred Ownership and operation of the Ports of Entry from GSD and DPS to NMDOT. Since 2016, DOT has been providing port maintenance and facility oversight for all ports regardless of ownership.

DOT has received legislative approval for 50 port staff positions. Since 2015, DOT has utilized temporary staffing at the ports to collect revenue. The DOT has completed the hiring process for the 50 positions.

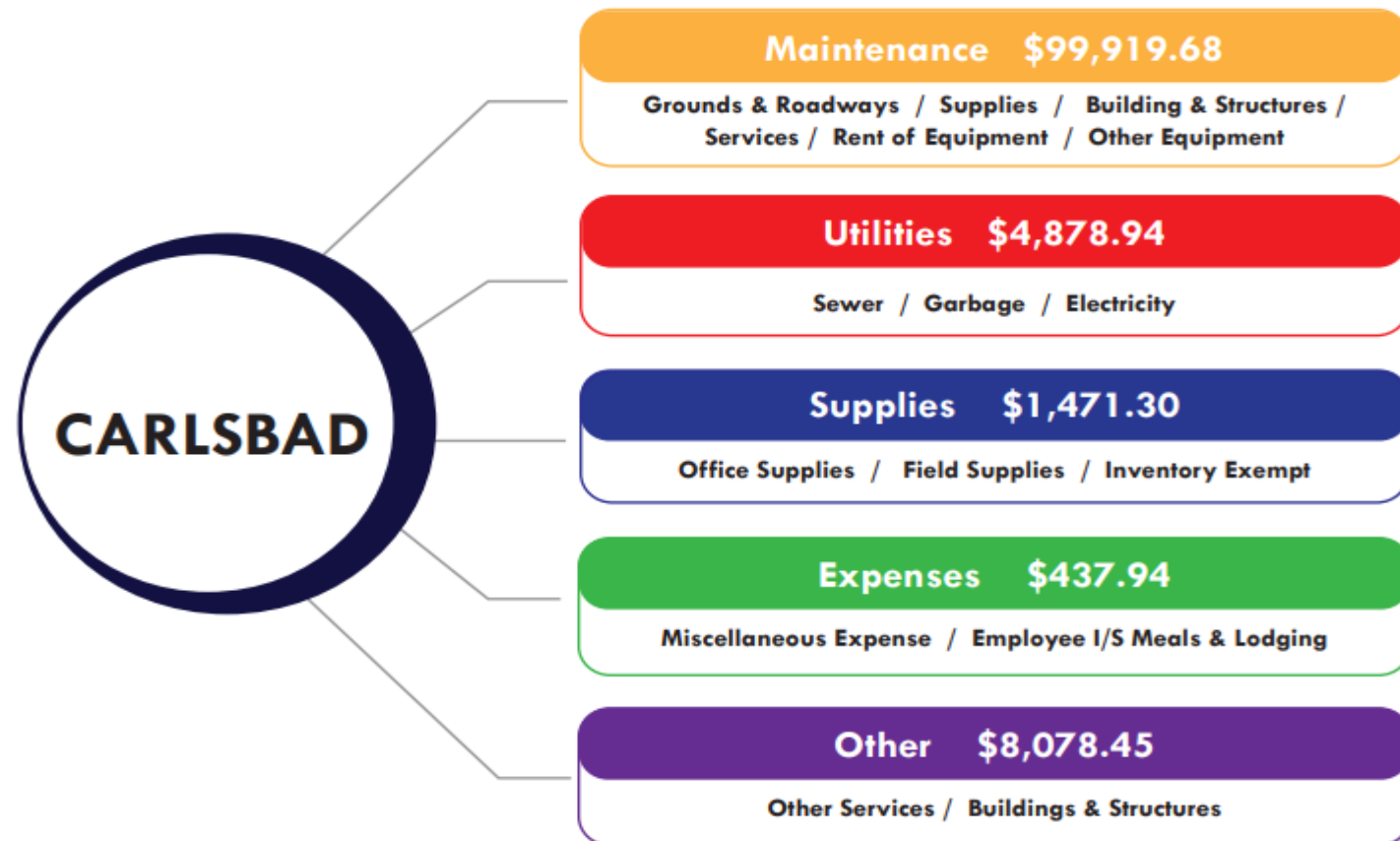
