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Maintenance/ Construction Funding:

HB 2 General Fund (Non-Recurring)

- FY20- NMDOT Received \$175M in appropriations.

 NMDOT has obligated/incumbered \$157.9M or 90% of appropriations.
- FY21- NMDOT Received \$135M in appropriations.

 NMDOT has obligated/incumbered \$133.4M or 99% of appropriations.
- FY22- NMDOT Received \$170M in appropriations. NMDOT has obligated/incumbered \$61.9M of appropriations or 36% of appropriations.
- FY23- NMDOT Received \$247.5M in appropriations.

 NMDOT has obligated/incumbered \$2.1M or 1% of appropriations.



Construction Funding:

2021 Bond Proceeds

*2021 Sold \$303.9M less \$75M to make projects whole from GF 2019 reversion.

*Each District received approx. \$28M

*NMDOT has obligated/encumbered \$151.9M or 50% of appropriations.

*\$142.5M Appropriated in Dec. of 2021

*No funding obligated/incumbered, \$25.4M identified for projects in FY 2024.


