


TIRS - October 2022 State of State **Report NMDOT District Three**

District Three is located within Central New Mexico and encompasses Bernalillo and Valencia County and portions of Southern Sandoval County and Extreme Northern Socorro County. Though the smallest geographically, District Three currently serves a population more than 910,000 which is projected to top 1,108,000 by 2040. Within the boundaries are sixteen (16) communities and eight (8) Tribal Governments. District Three is located at 7500 Pan American Freeway NE, Albuquerque, NM.
