Tobacco Settlement Appropriations

- Recurring tobacco settlement payments were expected to be \$3 million less in FY19 than FY18.
- Tobacco revenue appropriations to support Medicaid decreased by \$21 million for a total of \$7 million (See handout: Tobacco Settlement Fund Revenue FY17 to FY19).
- By statute, half of the money received was intended for programs and half was placed in permanent fund and generates investment revenue.
- > In recent years, the Legislature has suspended deposits into the permanent fund so revenue can be used to help support the Medicaid budget.

FY18 Tobacco Settlement Payment

FY18 tobacco settlement payment came in at \$35.7 million, \$3.3 million less than the FY18 appropriation of \$39 million. DFA implemented the following budget adjustments to the May and June agency allotments:
