HB 412	Jim R. Trujillo	Transfers \$150 million from the general fund operating reserve to the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Fund to restore funds diverted to meet state fiscal solvency requirements.	Died
HB 428	Stewart	Increases rate of tobacco products tax from 25% to 53%; clarifies that "tobacco products" includes tobacco for human consumption whether chewed, smoked, heated, absorbed, dissolved, inhaled, snorted, sniffed or ingested by any other means (other than federal Food and Drug Administration-approved tobacco-use cessation products).	Died
SFC/SFC/SB 113 & SEC/SB 392	JA Smith Michael S. Sanchez	Transfers one-fourth of the annual fiscal year 2014 Master Settlement Agreement (MSA) distribution from the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Fund to the Lottery Tuition Fund. This legislation also transfers one-fourth of the fiscal year 2014 MSA distribution from the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Fund to the Tobacco Settlement Program Fund for appropriation to the Children, Youth and Families Department for early childhood education programs. The governor vetoed a temporary provision in the bill to transfer \$50 million from the general fund operating reserve to the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Fund to restore funds diverted in the past to meet state fiscal solvency requirements.	Partial Veto
SB 516	Lopez	Clarifies sections of the Cigarette Tax Act with respect to "units sold"; increases civil and criminal penalties for violations of the Cigarette Tax Act and the Tobacco Escrow Fund Act (requested by the Office of the Attorney General).	Died
SJM 15	Ortiz y Pino	Requests a task force to study the relationship between tobacco use and employer costs, including impacts on organizations that employ tobacco users.	Died

SJM 24	Lopez	Requests the Legislative Education Study Committee, Public Education Department and Department of Health to appoint a work group to study high school health curriculum, including tobacco use.	Died
SM 22	Ortiz y Pino	Requests the formation of a task force to study the relationship between tobacco use and employer costs, including impacts on organizations that employ tobacco users; task force to report to the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee (LHHS) by November 1, 2013.	Passed
SM 63	Cervantes	Requests the governing body of any public post-secondary educational institution that does not have a smoke-free campus policy in place by July 1, 2013 to appear before the LHHS and Tobacco Settlement Revenue Oversight Committee by July 1, 2013 to report the reasons for the lack of such policy.	Passed
