Which leads to uniquely strong fire resistance - 3x less burning compared to rivers without beavers.

Even during megafires.

Outside River Corridor: 37% fire refugia

In Rivers, <u>No</u> Beavers: 60% fire refugia

In Rivers, <u>With</u> Beavers: 89% fire refugia
