
## National Disaster Trends AlDisasters

Disasters are happening more frequently and causing more damage than before.






#### 1980-2024 United States Billion-Dollar Disaster Year-to-Date Event Cost (CPI-Adjusted)

The 1980-2024 annual average is 9 events; the annual average for the most recent 5 years (2020–2024) is 23 events







### **Annual Cost of Disasters**




### **Federally Declared**
