- ▶ commerce department (.182953.1)
  - ▶ expand DFA to include GSD and SPO; abolish GSD (.182861.2)
  - ▶ require administrative services to be provided for administratively attached agencies (.182713.1)
  - ▶ exempt salaries plan to include salaries, including in general appropriation act (.182783.1)
  - ▶ same per diem and mileage rate for all public officers and employees (.182949.1)
  - ▶ sunset all boards and commissions (.182948.1)
  - ▶ legislative veto of state rules (CA) (.182946.1)
  - ▶ combine horse racing commission and gaming control board (.182723.1)

- ▶ combine homeland security, E911 and fire marshal with DPS (.182722.3) (move motor transportation division to DOT)

- ▶ medicaid functions (CoLTS) to HSD (question outstanding is transfer of personnel) (.182941.1)
- ▶ delay state educational retirement contribution (.183059.1)
- ▶ request SPO to conduct a review of exempt and classified administrative and managerial positions and salaries for each classification (joint memorial) (.182734.1)

**Staff Reports or Further Discussion on Bill Concepts:**

- ▶ department of environment and energy, minerals and natural resources department overlap
- ▶ agency attorneys and the AG — routine legal work in departments; bigger issues assigned to AG
- ▶ small school/small district size adjustment (LESC report)
- ▶ higher education and public education consolidation — constitutional amendment as first step (see .182821.2)
- ▶ educational finance division in DFA and move both HED and PED finance into that division — constitutional amendment as first step

**Bills Approved:**

- ▶ abolish PRC; duties as provided by law (CA) (.182745A.1) — companion bill to provide process for determining how duties will be parceled out was not recommended
- ▶ abolish public education commission, provide by law for powers and duties of PED (CA) (.182821.2) (previously considered w/o PEC abolishment)
- ▶ abolish New Mexico health policy commission; move functions to DOH (.182719.1)
- ▶ repeal state personnel board's authority to exempt positions from covered service (.182712.1)
- ▶ Intertribal Ceremonial Act repeal (.182720.1)
- ▶ juvenile public safety advisory board repeal (.182721.1)
- ▶ combine mining and surface mining commissions (.182729.1)
