

Statewide Impact of COE Outreach

- 3,000 In-Service Teachers received Professional Development
- 27,000 K-12 Students impacted
- 347 Administrators received professional development
- 2,000 Parents participated in outreach
- Recently graduated 86 Masters and 36 Ph.D. students in EDLT serving in 15 NM districts as administrators.

Key NMSU COE Outreach Programs

- STEM Outreach includes PD for Math and Science Teachers in 20 districts
- STEM Afterschool programs for students in 4 districts.
- CORE training in math and reading for K-3 teachers in 34 districts
- Educators Rising “Grow your own teachers” in 20 districts

These efforts funded by PED, HED, DOE, NSF, NASA, private foundations and corporations. **Over \$13,000,000 in the past 5 years.**
