New Programs and Services

- Cope Clinic at UNM Psychiatric Center
 - Serves as Home Clinic for Severely Disabled Mentally Ill (SDMI) consumers
 - Integrated Treatment Team with Psychiatrist Leadership, and Comprehensive Community Support Services
- UNM ASAP Primary Care Clinic
 - Provides onsite primary care services for addictions patients
- Psychiatric Urgent Care
 - Provides walk-in access for patients to same day services
- Behavioral Health Integration into primary care sites
- Development of Peer to Peer Services
 - Peer Linker Program (grant funded)
 - Peer Bridger Program (volunteer program)

New Programs and Services

- Expansion of the Start Clinic at UNM Psychiatric Center to facilitate access
 - Provides Psychiatric Evaluation and Short Term Intervention Services
- Integration of Outpatient Community Support Workers from Programs for Children with Children's Psychiatric Center Inpatient Care.
 - Facilitates care coordination, discharge planning and links back to community based treatment
- Opening of Geriatric Psychiatric Services at SRMC
- Expanded Tele-health Services
 - Psychiatric Emergency Services
 - Psychiatry Services through Project ECHO

Workforce Development

UNM provides Behavioral Health and Psychiatry training to multiple healthcare disciplines

- Thirty Eight Psychiatry Residents
 - Two Adult and Geriatric Psychiatry Fellows
 - Three Child Psychiatry Fellows
 - Two Addiction Psychiatry Fellows
 - Psychology Internship Program with Seven Interns
 - Psychiatric Nursing Students
 - Counseling and Social Work Interns
 - Physician Assistants and Advanced Practice Nurses seeking Psychiatric Specialty Training
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System Challenges and Issues

- ▶ Behavioral Health CPT code Changes do not support needed Services.
 - ▶ Reimbursement structures do not support community based services development.
 - ▶ Increased regulatory burden as it relates to Core Service Agencies and Utilization Management Activities
 - ▶ Increased Demand and Healthcare Reform will make access to services more difficult
 - ▶ Behavioral Reimbursement has been degraded over time. The system is very fragile.
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Community Needs and Response

- ▶ Community Feedback led in part to development of the creation of Psychiatric Urgent Care and the Cope Clinic.
 - ▶ To facilitate and expand access UNM Psychiatric Center has added Advanced Practice Providers.
 - ▶ Community Support Workers have been added at Children's Psychiatric Center to help increase care coordination activities.
 - ▶ Focus on Development of Behavioral Health Homes.
 - ▶ Development of Patient Centered Medical Homes with Behavioral Health Providers incorporated into treatment teams
