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The Patent Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA)

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- Was signed into law by President Barack Obama on March 23, 2010.
 - As of May 31, 2010, there have been a total of 77 PPACA grants released from the federal level.
 - Total awards to New Mexico: \$75,762,249
 - Total awards to state agencies: \$33,368,680

Tracking of PPACA Grants by the NM Office of Health Care Reform

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- Grant tracking is done on a daily basis by utilizing the Grant.gov website.
 - Once on the website “Advanced Search” is chosen from the left side menu.
 - Under the keyword search “Affordable Care Act” is entered.
 - Under “Search by Agency” choose “Department of Health and Human Services” and hit “Search.
 - This allows to filter out hundreds to thousands of other grants that do not pertain to PPACA.

Health Information Privacy (HIPAA)

The HIPAA Privacy Rule creates national standards to protect individuals' medical records and other personal health information.

Assistance with Grant Tracking

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- There are many state agencies that make up the NM Office of Health Care Reform Steering Committee. Each agency helps with grant tracking.
 - Once a grant is identified it is sent to the NM Office of Health Care Reform.
 - The Office of Health Care Reform then sends the grant information to the proper agency or listserv.
 - The Office of Health Care Reform will then do follow-up to see if an agency plans to apply for the grant.

PPACA Grant Tracking Outside of State Agencies

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- Many entities do not disclose if they have applied for or received PPACA funding. These include:
 - Private and public institutions of higher education
 - Private corporations
 - Tribes and tribal organizations
- Every effort is made to track grants to outside entities through grant announcements and award notifications.


PPACA Grants Awarded to State Agencies

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- As June 1, 2011 there have been a total of 17 grants awarded to seven state agencies:
 - Department of Workforce Solutions (1 Award)
 - Department of Health (6 Awards)
 - Human Services Department (4 Awards)
 - Public Regulation Commission Division of Insurance (2 Awards)
 - Aging and Long Term Services Department (2 Awards)
 - Children Youth and Families Department (1 Award)
 - Public Education Department (1 Award)

PPACA Funding by State Agency

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Totals for all state agencies as of June 1, 2011 is **\$33,368,680** (17 Grants Total)

Community Health Centers Grants

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- **Total for New Mexico: \$26,433,928**
 - **First Choice Community Healthcare, Inc. Albuquerque, NM: \$8,153,989**
 - **Ben Archer Health Center, Hatch, NM: \$5,778,210**
 - **La Clinica de Familia, Inc. Las Cruces, NM: \$3,786,635**
 - **Hidalgo Medical Services, Lordsburg, NM: \$8,715,094**

Qualifying Therapeutic Discovery Project Grants

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- **Total for New Mexico: \$4,725,875.62**
 - 20 private companies in New Mexico were awarded PPACA grants.
 - These awards were for 2009 and 2010.
 - These grants were mainly for research and development on various health issues.

Medicare Part D “Donut Hole” Rebate

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- **Total for New Mexico: \$4,985,250**
- **A tax-free rebate check of \$250 was issued to 19,941 New Mexicans.**
- **In 2011, beneficiaries will receive a 50% discount for brand-name prescriptions once they enter the donut hole.**

Workforce Grants

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- **Total for New Mexico: \$898,390**
 - **Advanced Nursing Education Expansion, UNM-HSC: \$38,333**
 - **Nurse Education, Practice, Quality and Retention, UNM-HSC: \$406,078**
 - **Nurse Education, Practice, Quality and Retention, Western NM University: \$249,740**
 - **Expansion of Physician Assistant Training Program, UNM-HSC: \$204,239**

Tribal Grants

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- **Total for New Mexico: \$408,000**
 - Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program, Native American Professional Parent Resources, Inc: \$300,000
 - Tribal Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program, Pueblo of San Felipe: \$100,00
 - Medicare Beneficiary Outreach and Assistance Program Funding For Title VI Native American Programs, 8 Tribes: \$1,000 per tribe (\$8,000 Total)
