The PNM Navajo Nation Workforce Training Program

The efforts began three years ago when PNM's San Juan Generating Station ordered to meet federal visibility standards.

PNM's goals were to be:

- Environmentally responsible

- Consider Cost impact to customers

- Economic Impacts to the Four Corners Region

The Navajo Nation was instrumental in helping EPA, PNM and the State of New Mexico arrive at a new solution.

Collaboration with the Navajo Nation created the PNM-Navajo Nation Workforce Training Program.

FIVE-YEAR COMMITMENT

- PNM Committed \$1 million over five years to train Navajo tribal members for future job opportunities
 - Announcement of PNM-Navajo Nation Workforce Training Program in August 2013.
 - \$200,000 beginning 2013 with funds going directly to partnering schools
 - Navajo Technical University, Crownpoint, New Mexico
 - San Juan College, Farmington New Mexico





NAVAJO WORKFORCE TRAINING UPDATE

San Juan College

- 77 students awarded scholarships in 25 different programs earning certificates or Associate Degrees at San Juan College and the San College School of Energy.
- Fields of Study - Chemistry, Diesel Mechanic, Engineering, Geology, Industrial Process Operator Instrumentation and Controls, Natural Gas Compression, Renewable Energy, Welding.
- 9 Navajo students graduated in May.

Navajo Technical University

- 47 Navajo students have been awarded scholarships in 12 different programs earning certificates, Associates Degrees.
- 15 are seeking Bachelor's Degrees.
- Fields of study - Electrical Trades, Construction Technology, Energy Systems, Computer Aided Drafting, Information Technology, Industrial Engineering, Environmental Science and Natural Resources.
- 12 Students Graduated in May


