


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NMSU-FHCRC Partnership for the Advancement of Cancer Research

- Promoting academic-community partnerships to reduce cancer risk and increase healthy lifestyles
 - Small grants
 - Health problems defined by community
- Fostering culturally competent cancer prevention and screening health care practices
 - Providing CME on cancer for NM medical practitioners
 - Developing research capacity and cultural competency (MMC)
- Conducting community health education
 - Cancer education (CRC, Cancer 101)
 - Healthy lifestyle education

Childhood Obesity Prevention

- Multi-institutional, 5-year intervention to prevent childhood obesity in border colonias in TX, NM & AZ
 - Partner institutions include Texas A&M, Baylor University and Mariposa Community Health Center
- Targets Mexican-origin children 7-11 years and their families in selected Otero and Luna County colonias
- Aims to improve diet, increase physical activity and reduce screen time at 1-year follow-up
- Intervention is driven by promotores de salud; includes research, education and Extension components
- Funding: USDA Agriculture and Food Research Initiative (AFRI)
 - \$4.9 million total
 - \$1.5 million sub-award to NMSU



Southwest Institute for Health Disparities Research (SWIHDR)

- **Mission**
 - Promote research, training and outreach to reduce health disparities in US-Mexico border communities
- **Resources**
 - FTE 0.25 since 8/2013
- **Activities and Accomplishments**
 - Annual conference (9/2014, 9/2015 pending)
 - Interdisciplinary research teams focused on Adolescent & Child Health, Adult Obesity, Healthy Aging, Violence and Trauma
 - USDA AFRI grant, 2015 - 2020 (\$1.5 million)
 - Other grants pending
