

New Mexico Border Authority's number one priority ranking project for FY15 Capital Outlay




Santa Teresa-San Jeronimo Rail Border Crossing


- Projected Jobs created:
Initial study stage created 6 jobs.
- Construction stage: this stage will create approximately 100 jobs
- Operations and Inspection: this stage will create approximately 20 jobs and probably comparable number in Mexico.



Binational Industrial Campus/FTZ




Dual Customs Clearance on Mexico side



- It will increase commerce, commercial traffic crossing both: north and south.
- It will increase staff of inspectors approximately 15 to 20 jobs
- In the construction phase this project will create 50 to 100 jobs
- It will make it a safer and more efficient transportation mode for the crossing.

Commercial Lanes next to Rail Border Crossing



- When the sub port develops, it will be in the need for more Customs Agents, being a 24/7 POE will require 3 shifts.
- Projected jobs: 50 to 60 new Customs Agents.
- Construction phase will employ hundreds of workers.
