

- \$750,000
- 20 year term
- PPRF loans secured and repaid by the Rural County Cancer Treatment Cigarette Tax.

## Nor-Lea Cancer Center


- 1) Established in 2006.
- 2) Expanded in 2009 with assistance from the Revenue Bond Series of 2009.
- 3) Expanded in late 2014 to current facility with assistance from Rural County Cancer Treatment Cigarette Tax Funds.



## Nor-Lea Cancer Center


- 1) Increase of over 3,000 procedures since initial funding.
- 2) 2006 Unit had 4 treatment chairs and 1 exam room.
- 3) 2009 unit had 6 treatment chairs, 1 exam room and 1 private bed.
- 4) Today's unit has 10 treatment chairs, 8 exam rooms, and 2 private beds. It is staffed with 4 RNs, 3 office staff, and one phlebotomist.
- 5) Dr. Quick, Dr. Tafur and Dr. Close provide the oncology coverage.
