**Background**

Created in statute in 2005 (Sections 22-24-7 and 22-24-8 NMSA 1978), the Public School Capital Outlay Oversight Task Force oversees the work of the Public School Capital Outlay Council and the Public School Facilities Authority as they implement the state's standards-based public school capital outlay funding methodology. The task force consists of 25 members (or their respective designees). State statute allows for a total of five meetings throughout the interim.

**Work Plan**

The task force will focus on the following activities during the 2015 interim:

1. monitoring the progress and effectiveness of programs administered pursuant to the Public School Capital Outlay Act and the Public School Capital Improvements Act in terms of continued implementation of the district court's order in the *Zuni* lawsuit;

2. examining existing permanent revenue streams to ensure that they remain adequate long-term funding sources for public school capital outlay projects, particularly in light of implementation of Laws 2015, Chapter 63 (House Bill 236);
3. overseeing the work of the Public School Capital Outlay Council and the Public School Facilities Authority;
4. monitoring the overall progress of bringing all public school facilities to the statewide adequacy standards developed pursuant to provisions in the Public School Capital Outlay Act, including examination of the original intent of the establishment of the standards-based process and its evolution as it has been implemented;
5. consideration of inclusion of teacherages in the standards-based process;
6. examining issues related to charter school facilities, including lease assistance from the state and utilization of public school buildings and other public buildings to accommodate charter schools, charter schools and the use of lease-purchase agreements and discussion of charter school compliance with the 2015 deadlines to be in public buildings;
7. reviewing progress on the implementation of Section 22-24-4.5 NMSA 1978, regarding establishment of a process to correct deficiencies in school districts' respective educational technology infrastructures in light of the electronic implementation of the state's student assessments of readiness for college and careers in the 2015-2016 school year;
8. examining school transportation capital outlay issues;
9. reviewing the oversight of maintenance of public school buildings;
10. reviewing provisions of the Public School Capital Outlay Act (including the capital outlay sliding scale formula and offsets), the Public School Capital Improvements Act and the Public School Buildings Act and making recommendations for changes as necessary; and
11. continuing to monitor the inclusion of the New Mexico School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the New Mexico School for the Deaf in the standards-based process.
