



- Eight individual teams set record high GPA's since Fall 2009, as have both the overall men's teams and the overall women's teams, and the entire student-athlete population.
- The 09-10 academic year was the best on record with a 3.12 fall and 3.15 spring GPA. The second highest was 08-09 with a 3.14 and 3.12. The 2010 calendar year boasted a 3.15 and 3.06.
- 13 of 17 teams had GPA's above a 3.00 in both Fall 2010 and Spring 2011



Lobos On Path to Graduation




Fall 2010 Graduation
