Thursday, November 10

Welcome and Introductions (9:22 a.m.)

Senator Rodriguez welcomed the committee and asked members and staff to introduce themselves.

Adoption of Rules Governing Loans from the Opportunity Enterprise Fund (9:28 a.m.)

Marquita Russel, chief executive officer, New Mexico Finance Authority (NMFA), reviewed the proposed adoption of rules governing the Opportunity Enterprise Revolving Fund loan program. The presentation can be found here:

Motion to Approve Rules (10:40 a.m.)

Upon a motion made and seconded, the committee unanimously voted to approve the rules governing the Opportunity Enterprise Revolving Fund loan program.

Approval of Minutes (10:40 a.m.)

On a motion made and seconded, the minutes of the May 27, August 29-30, September 26-27 and October 25-26, 2022 meetings were unanimously approved.

Consideration of Legislation for Endorsement (10:41 a.m.)

Ms. Russel provided an overview of four pieces of legislation for review and endorsement by the committee. Legislation proposed for endorsement can be found here:

.223386.1SA would authorize the NMFA to make loans from the Public Project Revolving Fund.

.223387.1SA would authorize the NMFA to make loans from the Water Project Fund for certain water projects.

.223405.1SA would appropriate funds from the Public Project Revolving Fund to the Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund, the Water and Wastewater Project Grant Fund, the Cultural Affairs Facilities Infrastructure Fund and the Local Government Planning Fund.

.223179.1 is an omnibus "cleanup" bill with amendments across ten acts to expand the reach of existing programs, increase accessibility to existing programs, improve operating efficiency, align definitions, provisions and reporting dates and eliminate inactive programs.

Motion to Endorse Legislation (11:14 a.m.)

Upon a motion made and seconded, the committee unanimously voted to endorse the following legislation: NMFA authorization to make loans from the Public Project Revolving Fund (.223386.1); NMFA authorization to make loans or grants from the Water Project Fund (.223387.1SA); and NMFA appropriation of funds from the Public Project Revolving Fund to the Drinking Water State Revolving Loan Fund, the Water and Wastewater Project Grant Fund, the Cultural Affairs Facilities Infrastructure Fund and the Local Government Planning Fund (.223405.1SA).
