D. As used in th<u>is section, "trash" means any</u> 6 7 article or substance that when discarded creates or 8 contributes to an unsanitary, offensive or unsightly 9 condition. "Trash" includes waste food; paper products; 10 cans, bottles and other containers; household furnishings and 11 equipment; parts or bodies of vehicles and other metallic 12 junk or scrap; and collections of ashes, dirt, yard trimmings 13 and other rubbish."

Section 2. Section 66-8-116 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, Chapter 35, Section 524, as amended) is amended to read:

"66-8-116. PENALTY ASSESSMENT MISDEMEANORS--DEFINITION--SCHEDULE OF ASSESSMENTS.--

and no probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred
sentence shall exceed ninety days."

Section 3. REPEAL.--Section 30-8-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1963, Chapter 303, Section 8-7) is repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2000.
