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The tax rebate provided for in this section may Β. 3 be deducted from the taxpayer's New Mexico income tax 4 liability for taxable year 2000. If the tax rebate exceeds 5 the taxpayer's income tax liability, the excess shall be 6 refunded to the taxpayer.

The rebate provided for in this section may be С. claimed only on a return filed for taxable year 2000.

D. A husband and wife who file separate returns for taxable year 2000 and could have filed a joint return for taxable year 2000 may each claim only one-half of the tax rebate that would have been allowed on the joint return."

Section 2. APPLICABILITY.--The provisions of this act apply to the 2000 taxable year.

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
