AN ACT

RELATING TO COURTS; PROVIDING THAT A BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS IS NOT REQUIRED TO PROVIDE QUARTERS FOR
JUVENILE PROBATION SERVICES; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA
1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 34-6-24 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1968,
Chapter 69, Section 25, as amended) is amended to read:

"34-6-24. OPERATION--LOCATION OF COURT--FACILITIES.--In
each county, the district court shall be held at the county
seat. Each board of county commissioners shall provide
adequate quarters for the operation of the district court
[including juvenile probation services] and provide necessary
utilities and maintenance service for the operation and
upkeep of district court facilities. From the funds of each
judicial district, furniture, equipment, books and supplies
