#### **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 461 appropriates \$170.0 to SDE to support the Magdalena Municipal School District's alternative education program.

#### Significant Issues

This bill provides additional funding to support the Magdalena Municipal School District's alternative education program that provides educational services for early prevention of school failure for pre-school children and an alternative educational setting for at-risk youth to complete high school.

SDE indicates the pre-school program focuses on the development of pre-reading skills, literacy and communication/language skills. The alternative program focuses on students who have either dropped out or are at-risk of dropping out of school. The program prepares students for the GED exam or high school diploma through non-traditional teaching methods.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

House Bill 461 appropriates \$170.0 to SDE for expenditure in fiscal year 2001. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2001 shall revert to the general fund.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS**

SDE will allocate funds and monitor the program with existing staff.
