## **SUMMARY**

### Synopsis of Bill

HM 16 requests the New Mexico Veterans' Service Commission (NMVSC) to disseminate to all veterans, families of veterans and New Mexico veterans associations information on a new bill passed by the U.S. Congress entitling veterans to a dividend on GI insurance.

### Significant Issues

The memorial states that eligible veterans will not receive a dividend or notice of possible dividend unless they ask for it from the U.S. veterans administration.
