SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 21 appropriates \$1,500.0 from the general fund to contract with community domestic violence shelters to provide services to victims of domestic violence and their families statewide.

Significant Issues

Senate Bill 21 is for the Legislative Health and Human Services Committee. The appropriation is to the Children, Youth and Families Department.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill appropriates \$1,500.0 from the general fund and is recurring.

The Legislative Finance Budget Recommendation includes \$900.0 from the Tobacco settlement funds to enhance the domestic programs within the department.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS
