8 central purchasing through the state purchasing office; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general services
10 department, office of the attorney general and legislative
11 council service be requested to assist in the study; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study team make an
13 interim report to the legislative finance committee by
14 September 2000 and a final report to the legislature by
15 January 2001; and

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
17 transmitted to the director of the legislative finance
18 committee, the director of the legislative council service,
19 the attorney general, the governor, the secretary of finance
20 and administration and the secretary of general services.
