11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PAY THE SETTLEMENT COSTS OF *D. W.*
12 *FALLS INVESTMENTS V. STATE OF NEW MEXICO* AND THE COSTS RELATED
13 TO THE ACQUISITION OF THE REMAINING PRIVATE PROPERTY IN THE
14 PETROGLYPH NATIONAL MONUMENT; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One million dollars
18 (\$1,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
19 department of finance and administration for expenditure in
20 fiscal years 2001 and 2002 to pay the settlement costs of *D. W.*
21 *Falls Investments v. State of New Mexico* and the costs related
22 to the acquisition of the remaining private property taken by
23 the state within the boundaries of the petroglyph national
24 monument. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at
25 the end of fiscal year 2002 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect
immediately.
