FOR INFRASTRUCTURE RENOVATION AND EXPANSION AT HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS AND CONSTITUTIONAL SPECIAL SCHOOLS STATEWIDE.

I request that the following capital outlay projects be funded:

I to the commission on higher education

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to connect the campus fire alarm system to a central monitoring station, install an emergency phone system throughout the campus and re-roof the occupational technology center at eastern New Mexico university Roswell campus in Chaves county;

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) for infrastructure improvements, installation of a digital control system for all mechanical units and a security access system at the university of New Mexico Gallup campus in McKinley county;

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for infrastructure renovations and expansion, including repairs to Ninth, Eleventh and San Francisco streets and Mora avenue at New Mexico Highlands university in Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

one million seven hundred thousand dollars (\$1,700,000) for infrastructure improvements, including necessary replacements and expansion of aging centralized systems, at New Mexico institute of mining and technology in Socorro in Socorro county;

ten million five hundred thousand dollars (\$10,500,000) for renewal of the mechanical system at Williams hall, replacement of major components at the central utility plant and replacement of portions of the five kilovolt electrical distribution system at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county;

seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) for core building renewal and renovation of various existing facilities at the university of New Mexico in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) for infrastructure improvements, including necessary replacements and expansion of aging centralized systems, and renovation of existing facilities at New Mexico state university community college central campus in Dona Ana county;

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for infrastructure improvements, renovation and expansion to existing facilities at New Mexico state university Alamogordo campus in Otero county;

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for infrastructure improvements, renovation and expansion to existing facilities at New Mexico state university Carlsbad campus in Eddy county;

one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) to renovate Lea Hall at New Mexico military institute in Roswell in Chaves county;

six hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$625,000) for upgrading campus infrastructure such as roads, parking lots, sidewalks, utilities and telecommunication systems at eastern New Mexico university in Portales in Roosevelt county.

one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) for infrastructure improvements, including necessary replacements and expansion of aging centralized systems, at Albuquerque technical-vocational institute in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county;

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for installation of a new roof at the eastern New Mexico university Ruidoso instruction center in Lincoln county;

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for improvements to the hot water lines, electrical systems and concrete driveways and walkways at the New Mexico junior college in Hobbs in Lea county;

two million five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$2,575,000) for infrastructure improvements, including necessary replacements and expansion of aging centralized systems, at western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county;

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for infrastructure upgrades and site improvements at San Juan college in Farmington in San Juan county;

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for infrastructure improvements to the underground electrical distribution and energy management system at Luna vocational-technical institute in Las Vegas in San Miguel county;

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to renovate and add on to a 1936 adobe building used for the barbering-cosmetology department at northern New Mexico state school in El Rito in Rio Arriba county;

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for roof replacement and infrastructure improvements at the Santa Fe community college in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county;

five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for infrastructure improvements, including necessary improvements to comply with health, safety and accessibility requirements at the New Mexico school for the deaf in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county; and

three hundred forty-three thousand dollars (\$343,000) for infrastructure improvements, renovation and expansion to existing facilities at New Mexico state university Grants campus in Cibola county; and

I to the board of regents of northern New Mexico state school

five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$575,000) for infrastructure renovations and site improvements at northern New Mexico state school in Espanola in Rio Arriba county.
