1           WHEREAS, the public regulation commission will need an  
2 estimated additional five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000)  
3 in its budget to pay rent for either Marian hall or for a  
4 replacement space; and

5           WHEREAS, it is desirable that any relocation take place  
6 with a minimum of disruption to the public regulation  
7 commission's ongoing duties; and

8           WHEREAS, it is desirable that the public regulation  
9 commission be housed in a single building; and

10           WHEREAS, it is possible that following the sale of Marian  
11 hall it will be leased to the state and that public regulation  
12 commission employees now working in Marian hall may continue  
13 to be located there to minimize disruption; and

14           WHEREAS, it is prudent to identify office space options to  
15 house the public regulation commission; and

16           WHEREAS, some of the tenant agencies now located in the  
17 public employees retirement association building may relocate,  
18 making additional space available for the public regulation  
19 commission in that building;

20           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE  
21 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the general services department be  
22 directed to identify and negotiate for office space to house  
23 the public regulation commission in the main capitol area in  
24 downtown Santa Fe; and

25           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general services

1 department be directed to consult on an ongoing basis with and  
2 obtain the prior approval of the public regulation commission  
3 for office space to house the public regulation commission, and  
4 report on its progress and efforts on this matter to the  
5 legislature; and

7 department locate and negotiate for space that meets the  
8 present and future needs of the public regulation commission;  
9 and

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be  
11 transmitted to the general services department and the public  
12 regulation commission.
