10 A JOINT RESOLUTION

11 PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 4 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW
12 MEXICO TO LIMIT THE TERMS OF STATE LEGISLATORS.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 4, Section 4
16 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

17 "Members of the legislature shall be elected as follows:
18 [~~those senators from Bernalillo, Chaves, Curry, DeBaca, Grant,~~
19 ~~Lea, Lincoln, Luna, Sandoval, San Juan, San Miguel, Socorro,~~
20 ~~Taos, Torrance, Union and Valencia counties for a term of six~~
21 ~~years starting January 1, 1961, and after serving such terms~~
22 ~~shall be elected for a term of four years thereafter; those~~
23 ~~senators from all other counties for the terms]~~ senators for
24 terms of four years and members of the house of representatives

1 for ~~[a-term]~~ terms of two years. ~~[They]~~ Excluding service in
2 the legislature prior to the first session of the forty-sixth
3 legislature or appointment to a vacant office, a legislator
4 shall not serve more than a total of four terms in the senate
5 and eight terms in the house of representatives. Senators and
6 members of the house of representatives shall be elected on the
7 day provided by law for holding the general election of state
8 officers or representatives in congress. If a vacancy occurs
9 in the office of senator or member of the house of
10 representatives, for any reason, the county commissioners of
11 the county wherein the vacancy occurs shall fill such vacancy
12 by appointment.

13 Such legislative appointments as provided in this section
14 shall be for a term ending on December 31, subsequent to the
15 next succeeding general election. "

16 Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
17 shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
18 rejection at the next general election or at any special
19 election prior to that date which may be called for that
20 purpose.
