- "Section 2. FINDINGS OF FACT. -- The legislature finds that the 2001 Senate Redistricting Act meets all of the constitutional and statutory requirements governing redistricting of state legislative bodies in that the act:
 - A. creates districts that are compact and contiguous;
- B. creates districts that are substantially equal in population, with no more than a plus or minus five percent deviation from the ideal:
- C. does not violate provisions of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, concerning dilution of racial or language minority voting strength; and
- D. creates or preserves majority-minority districts where necessary, but does not subordinate traditional districting criteria to race.".
