A MEMORIAL

EXPRESSING CONDOLENCES OF THE SENATE TO THE FAMILY OF ALFRED
G. MARCHAND OF ALAMOGORDO, WHO WAS KILLED BY TERRORISTS IN THE
WORLD TRADE CENTER ATTACK.

WHEREAS, Alfred G. Marchand, a resident of Alamogordo,
was a flight attendant on one of the aircraft that was
hijacked and crashed into the World Trade Center; and

WHEREAS, Al retired after twenty-one years of service
with the Alamogordo department of public safety; and

WHEREAS, while serving his community, he was promoted to
sergeant in 1987, was the first narcotics officer assigned to
the Otero county narcotics enforcement unit in 1990, was
promoted to lieutenant in 1993 and retired in 2001; and

WHEREAS, he was a highly decorated officer, being awarded
Officer of the Year in 1982, the combat cross, three

7 WHEREAS, he was warm, kind and gentle with all people but

9 he will be sorely missed by the whole community;
