AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Eight million dollars (\$8,000,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the development training fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2002 and subsequent fiscal years for a development training program providing classroom and in-plant training to furnish qualified manpower resources for certain new or expanding industries and businesses in the state. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION--TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE FOR
NEEDY FAMILIES BLOCK GRANT.--Two million dollars (\$2,000,000)
is appropriated from the temporary assistance for needy
families block grant to the income support division of the
human services department to be transferred to the
development training fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2003
and subsequent fiscal years for a development training
program providing classroom and in-plant training to furnish
qualified manpower resources for certain new or expanding
industries and businesses in the state. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year

shall not revert.

Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
