15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted
17	to read:
18	"[NEW MATERIAL] AGGRAVATED FLEEING AN OFFICER
19	A. Aggravated fleeing an officer consists of a
20	person driving his vehicle carelessly and heedlessly in
21	willful or wanton disregard of the rights or safety of others,
22	without due caution and circumspection and at a speed or in a

manner so as to endanger or be likely to endanger another

person or property, after being given a visual or audible

signal to stop, whether by hand, voice, emergency light,

flashing light, siren or other signal, by a uniformed officer in an appropriately marked police vehicle.

 $\hbox{\bf B.} \quad \hbox{\bf Whoever commits aggravated fleeing an officer}$  is guilty of a fourth degree felony. "}

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. -- The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2002.
