AN ACT

RELATING TO GLASS BEVERAGE CONTAINERS; ENACTING THE BEVERAGE  
CONTAINER DEPOSIT ACT; ESTABLISHING A DEPOSIT FEE;  
ESTABLISHING A REFUND FEE AND PROVIDING FOR REFUNDS ON GLASS  
BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SHORT TITLE.--This act may be cited as the  
"Beverage Container Deposit Act".

Section 2. DEFINITIONS.--As used in the Beverage  
Container Deposit Act:

A. "beverage" means beer or other malt beverages  
and mineral water, soda water and similar carbonated soft  
drinks in liquid form and intended for human consumption;

B. "beverage container" means the individual,  
separate, sealed glass container containing a beverage;

1 C. "consumer" means a person who purchases a  
2 beverage in a beverage container for use or consumption;

3 D. "dealer" means a person in New Mexico who  
4 engages in the sale of beverages in beverage containers to a  
5 consumer;

6 E. "department" means the department of  
7 environment;

8 F. "distributor" means a person who engages in the  
9 sale of beverages in beverage containers to a dealer,  
10 including a manufacturer who engages in these sales;

11 G. "manufacturer" means a person bottling  
12 beverages or filling glass beverage containers for sale to  
13 distributors or dealers; and

14 H. "place of business" means the location at which  
15 a dealer sells or offers for sale beverages in beverage  
16 containers to consumers.

17 Section 3. REFUND VALUE REQUIRED. --The price of every  
18 beverage container sold or offered for sale shall include a  
19 deposit fee of five cents (\$.05) and have a refund value of  
20 not less than five cents (\$.05).

21 Section 4. PRACTICES REQUIRED OF DEALERS AND  
22 DISTRIBUTORS. --

23 A. A dealer shall not refuse to accept from a  
24 person an empty beverage container of the kind, size and brand  
25 sold by the dealer or refuse to pay to that person the refund

1 value of a beverage container as established by Section 3 of  
2 the Beverage Container Deposit Act.

3 B. A distributor shall not refuse to accept from a  
4 dealer an empty beverage container of the kind, size and brand  
5 sold by the distributor or refuse to pay to that dealer the  
6 refund value of a beverage container as established by Section  
7 3 of the Beverage Container Deposit Act.

8 Section 5. DEALER OR DISTRIBUTOR AUTHORIZED TO REFUSE TO  
9 ACCEPT OR PAY REFUND IN CERTAIN CASES-- NOTICE. --

10 A. A dealer may refuse to accept from a person,  
11 and a distributor may refuse to accept from a dealer, an empty  
12 beverage container that does not state thereon a refund value  
13 as established by Section 3 of the Beverage Container Deposit  
14 Act.

15 B. A dealer may refuse to accept and to pay the  
16 refund value of a beverage container visibly containing or  
17 contaminated by a substance other than water, residue of the  
18 original contents or ordinary dust.

19 C. A dealer may refuse to accept and to pay the  
20 refund value of more than one hundred forty-four individual  
21 beverage containers returned by one person during one day.

22 D. In order to refuse containers under Subsection  
23 B or C of this section, the dealer must post in each area of  
24 its place of business where containers are received a clearly  
25 visible and legible sign containing the following information:

"NOTICE

New Mexico law allows a dealer to refuse to accept:

1. beverage containers visibly containing or contaminated by a substance other than water, residue of the original contents or ordinary dust; or

2. more than 144 individual beverage containers from one person during one day. "

Section 6. INDICATION OF REFUND VALUE REQUIRED. -- Every beverage container sold or offered for sale in this state by a dealer shall clearly indicate by embossing or by a stamp, label or other method securely affixed to the beverage container, the refund value of the container.
