A MEMORIAL

RECOGNIZING AND CONGRATULATING PARTICIPANTS IN "OPERATION AVALANCHE", A COMBINED AND COORDINATED FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT EFFORT IN TAOS COUNTY.

WHEREAS, drug law violations have been a serious problem in Taos county; and

WHEREAS, to respond to the illicit activities of persons buying and selling drugs, a coordinated and combined law enforcement effort was planned and implemented over a period of more than sixteen months, culminating in the arrests of law violators and a reduction in the crime rate of sixty-five percent; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement personnel often worked eighteen to twenty hours a day, accruing a total of more than one thousand six hundred overtime hours in bringing Operation
